Prices for the new financial year

The costs of many services/goods to the Sports Club have gone up considerably in the last two years and these have included the very considerable increase in energy prices that business and domestic users have suffered. Our insurance, unsurprisingly, also went up following the flood of 2007.

While we always try to absorb as much as we can, it is essential that we keep the club in profit. As a result of considerable discussion by the Sports Club Board, (made up of each of the sports club section's chairmen and myself), you will see an immediate increase in bar prices in line with suppliers costs to us. There will also be a small increase of £5/per capita on the CFC (central function contribution) from April 2010. Car park charges, though not affecting members, have already been raised and this has given us a very good boost to funds. Food prices will remain unchanged.

Can you help?

Of course we would love you to use the bar and catering facilities more but as well as that a very effective way to raise additional money for the club is through lettings and car park usage by non members:

- Can you encourage friends or business colleagues to consider using the excellent and competitively priced, fully catered facilities we offer for meetings/workshops/celebrations.
- Would any of your friends or business acquaintances like to buy 'annual' parking with us which would include social membership of the club?
- Would any of you like to buy business parking which would be charged at the standard district council cost – less CFC charge + a bar/food concession.
